BACKGROUND

There are several PPP projects the Public Private Partnership Commission (PPPC) is undertaking. All these are PPP projects that require some feasibility studies to be done. The various projects are from different sectors (various Government Departments and Entities) and require a lot of effort in order to come up with a feasibility study to ensure that the Projects are viable or not. The PPPC does not have enough time and resources to carry out such feasibility studies, they need the assistance of some competent PPP Feasibility Study Individual Consultant (Advisor) to assist.

SCOPE

The Advisor's assistance on the Feasibility studies will include detailed assessment of the following key issues:

- The needs analysis
- The solution options analysis
- Project due diligence -
- Value assessment
- Risk assessment and mitigation.
- Economic valuation.
- Procurement Processes

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION INTEREST

The Commission now invites Expressions of Interest from interested individual Consultants to provide documentary evidence that they are qualified to undertake such an assignment. The shortlisting criteria will be as follows:

- Evidence of having done similar work for at least five (5) years
- Evidence that they are qualified by producing documentary evidence of their qualification and experience of not less than 5 years in less developed countries
- Provide a list of organizations they have done similar work for the past seven (7) years
- Demonstrate knowledge of challenges faced in coming up with Feasibility studies in less developed countries for PPP projects
- Demonstrate thoroughly knowledge of all stages of a Feasibility study for a PPP Project

The exercise will be done on a task order basis with an estimated effort of 250man days over a period of three (3) years.
