PRESS RELEASE

The Government of Malawi (GoM) through the Ministry responsible for Irrigation, with support from the World Bank, Global Environmental Facility and African Development Bank is developing a new irrigation scheme, the Shire Valley Transformation Programme. The irrigation scheme is under construction and will be owned by the GoM.

The Public Private Partnership Commission (PPPC) invited Request for Expressions of Interest through the Local Newspapers and Online inviting Prospective Respondents to indicate their interest in the Operation, Management and Maintenance (OMM) Contract that shall include;

- (i) operating and maintaining the irrigation infrastructure,
- (ii) administering about 20 wholesale Irrigation Water Purchase Agreements, including billing and collection of irrigation water fees, and
- (iii) liaising with local communities. The OMM contract will not involve any agribusiness activity

The closing date for submission of expression of interest was 29th September 2020. Prospective bidders are advised that the submission date has been extended to 11th November 2020

Interested bidders are therefore encouraged to take advantage of the extension to submit their applications through the address below. Bidders who already submitted their applications need not to apply.
