The PPPC is also mandated to facilitate divestiture of state-owned enterprises through various divestiture modes as stipulated in the PPP Act. In undertaking these PPP and divestiture transactions, transport services play a critical role hence the need for new Motor vehicles and new ICT Equipment
2. The PPPC now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the supply and delivery of new Motor vehicles and ICT Equipment.

5. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on request from the address below (in 7) and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **MK5, 000.00** for each bid. The method of payment will be Cash.

Bids must be delivered to the address below (in 8) and deposited in a box marked **“Tender Box”** that is placed at the Reception Area at or before **14:00 Hours** Local Time on **Tuesday, 6th October, 2020**. *Electronic bid submission will not be accepted.* Bids for supply and delivery of Motor Vehicle must be accompanied with a bid security of **MWK250, 000.00** and bids for the supply and delivery of ICT Equipment must be accompanied with a **Bid Declaration Form**. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders’ representatives, who choose to attend at the address below (in 9) at **14:00 Hours** local time on **6th October, 2020**.
